Terms & Conditions of Driver for a Fiver Experience

Please take a moment to read and acknowledge these T&C's. This will help ensure your safety whilst on the footplate and the safety of our staff and passengers. We hope you enjoy your day with us.

1. General Information

- 1.1. The "Driver for a Fiver" experience is operated by Mid-Norfolk Railway Preservation Trust (MNRPT).
- 1.2. By purchasing a ticket for this experience, participants agree to comply with these terms and conditions.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1. Participants must be aged **18 or over**. MNRPT reserves the right to ask for proof of age.
- 2.2. All participants must be in good health and physically able to climb into and operate a locomotive safely.
- 2.3. Any medical conditions, disabilities, or mobility restrictions must be disclosed at the time of purchase.

3. Booking and Payment

- 3.1. The "Driver for a Fiver" experience is subject to availability.
- 3.2. Payment is required in full at the time of the experience. Tickets are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled by Mid-Norfolk Railway.

4. Experience Details

- 4.1. The "Driver for a Fiver" experience allows participants to drive a heritage diesel locomotive under the supervision of a qualified instructor.
- 4.2. The experience typically lasts for approximately 4 – 5 minutes and covers a short section of the railway. The exact duration may vary depending on operational circumstances.
- 4.3. Participants will receive a safety briefing before the experience begins.

5. Safety, Conduct, and Authority

- 5.1. Safety is the highest priority. Participants must follow all instructions given by Mid-Norfolk Railway staff and instructors.
- 5.2. Participants must listen to and always obey the instructions of the qualified Mid-Norfolk Railway driver.**
- 5.3. The qualified driver reserves the right to cancel the experience and retake control of the locomotive at any time if they deem it necessary for safety or operational reasons.**
- 5.4. Consumption of alcohol or drugs before or during the experience is strictly prohibited.**
- 5.5. The railway reserves the right to refuse participation to anyone deemed unfit, under the influence of substances, or acting in a disruptive manner.



6. Weather and Operational Changes

6.1. The experience is subject to weather and operational conditions. In cases of severe weather, technical issues, or unforeseen circumstances, Mid-Norfolk Railway may reschedule or cancel the experience.

7. Liability

7.1. Mid-Norfolk Railway accepts no liability for personal injury or damage to property unless caused by negligence on the part of the railway.

7.2. Participants take part in the experience at their own risk.

8. Photography and Media

8.1. Participants and their companions may take photographs during the experience unless otherwise instructed.

8.2. Mid-Norfolk Railway reserves the right to take photographs or videos of participants for promotional purposes.

9. Amendments and Cancellations by Participants

9.1. Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable.

10. Governing Law

10.1. These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.
